

Vailog Leases 19,000 m² to E-Mart in Songjiang Logistics Park Phase 3 in Shanghai



Shanghai, August 31, 2011 — Vailog today announces that it has signed a lease agreement with **E-Mart** in Vailog Songjiang Logistics Park Phase 3 in Shanghai, totaling approximately 19,000 square meters. After entering into the lease agreement with E-Mart, the park is now 100% occupied.

E-Mart, the largest retailer in South Korea, takes 3 units of approx. 19,000 sqm in the newly-built warehouse in Songjiang Logistics Park Phase 3. These logistics facilities will function as E-Mart's largest distribution centre in East China, which will greatly improve the efficiency of its logistics system.

Located in West Shanghai, Vailog Songjiang Logistics Park has good immediate access to the major Expressways in Shanghai including G15, G60 and S20 Expressway. The park comprises three warehouses with a total building area of 120,000 square meters and now has been fully leased out.



E-Mart was founded in 1993 by Shinsegae and is now the largest retailer in Korea having 127 stores across the country. E-Mart is also the first Korean retailer coming to China and now has opened 27 stores.



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
