

Vailog starts construction in Almere (Amsterdam) 20,000 m2 pre-let to Geodis



On June 15 2009, Vailog starts the works of Geodis' new distribution center in Almere's Stichtsekant industrial park. Just 25 km from downtown Amsterdam, Stichtsekant is ideally located for distribution on a regional and national scale. The new distribution center has a total size of 19,000 m2 and will be built at the highest construction standards for modern logistics.

The tenant Geodis is a 100% subsidiary of France's national railways company (SNCF) and is one of Europe's largest logistics provider, with annual sales exceeding Eur 5 billion (2008) and over 25,000 employees worldwide.

The new distribution center will serve the logistics needs of Geodis' customer Prénatal, Europe's largest chain of stores specialized in children care.

This new project in Almere is Vailog's second development in the Netherlands, after the distribution center developed in Venlo in 2008 and equally leased to Geodis.
